## Taipei Camellias Show



Mid-January

Location | Floriculture Experiment Center, Yangmingshan

The Floriculture Experiment Center in Yangmingshan has the oldest Camellia garden in Taiwan, with more than 300 varieties of camellia collected in the garden. Thanks to the unique natural climate and slightly acidic soil, it has become an ideal environment for thousands of camellias to grow. Many "early-blooming camellia" varieties begin blooming at the first hint of winter, forming a beautiful floral tunnel. With the sunlight gleaming through branches and petals falling to the ground, you will feel as if transported to a beautiful scene in a movie. Come admire the elegant bonsai plants and experience this unique camellia forest for yourself.

## Azalea Festival x Floral Picnic



March

Location | Daan Forest Park and around South Town Area

As spring blossoms, Taipei's city flower, the azalea, brightens the season with its delicate pink hues, adding a touch of romance to the cityscape.

The Azalea Festival is held at Daan Forest Park, blending the beauty of spring with vibrant activities in the nearby South Town Area. Families and friends can enjoy a variety of musical performances, hands-on workshops, and the "Taipei Floral Picnic"—a festive gathering adorned with stunning floral displays and delicious treats. Come experience the irresistible allure of Taipei in bloom. Stroll among the flowers, savor delightful bites, and immerse yourself in the lilting melodies of spring.

## Shan-Tseng-Chi Flower Festival



Late January to March

Location | Ki-Pataw Shan-Tseng-Chi Park

Once a Ketagalan settlement, Shan-Tseng-Chi carries a historical legacy spanning four centuries. Today, the Shan-Tseng-Chi Park sits on a hillside with a stunning landscape design featuring the great-crested vulture in full wingspan—a powerful symbol of protection over the land, as if guarding its young. From the park's elevated vantage point, visitors can enjoy a panoramic view of Beitou as if through the eyes of this majestic bird.

In spring, over 80,000 blooms—lavender, begonias, carnations, and more—come alive in a vibrant sea of color, flowing along the slopes in waves. This layered floral tapestry, whether admired from above or enjoyed through a leisurely stroll, offers a captivating experience of the Shan-Tseng-Chi Flower Festival.

## Taipei Rose Festival



Mid-March to Mid-April

Location | Xincheng Area of Taipei Expo Park

The largest rose festival in northern Taiwan can be found at the Taipei Rose Garden, where more than 800 varieties and more than 5,000 roses from all over the world are cultivated. Experience the timeless beauty and fragrant delight of different varieties of roses all year round.

The park features special exhibition areas such as "Secret Garden," "The Multicolored Rose Garden," "The Breeder's Garden," "The Tea Rose and Old Garden Rose Area" and "The Cultivars Area." The romantic atmosphere of this European-style garden makes it a perfect dating spot for couples.

## LOHAS Cherry Blossom Festival



Late January to February

Location | Neihs LOHAS Park

Each February, LOHAS Park transforms into Taipei's most romantic destination for nighttime cherry blossom viewing. Early blooming cherry trees and double-flowered cherry blossoms unfold in succession, tinting the landscape with dreamy pink hues that fill the air with love, as if brushed by a divine hand.

Stroll along scenic pathways with the soothing sounds of the Neigou Creek at your side. By day, the cherry blossoms radiate fresh, delicate beauty; by night, they take on a magical glow under soft lighting, creating an atmosphere of romance and wonder. Easily accessible by MRT, LOHAS Park is the perfect spot for a family outing or a memorable date. Come immerse yourself in the enchanting night blossoms and enjoy this unique romantic experience.

## Zhuzihu Calla Lily & Hydrangea Festival



Calla Lilies | Mid-March to Mid-April

Location | Zhuzihu Area (Bamboo Lake) of Yangmingshan

Surrounded by layers of green mountains, Zhuzihu (Bamboo Lake) is 670 meters above sea level and has a rich natural ecology. Overlooking Xiaoyoukeng, Zhuzihu is a popular wedding photo location and is listed as one of the top attractions in Taipei during springtime. This area is one of the few natural environments in Taiwan suitable for the cultivation of calla lilies. The flowering period is from January to May every year, and the peak flowering period is from March to April, with the output accounting for more than 80% of Taiwan's white calla lilies.

## Yangmingshan Flower Festival



Late January to Mid-March

Location | Yangming Park

The annual Yangmingshan Flower Festival has been attracting visitors from all over the world for more than 60 years. In addition to the spring scenery of the mountains and the "Flower Clock" of Yangmingshan, visitors will also be surrounded by a variety of cherry blossoms, including Yamazakura, Kanzakura, Yaezakura, Shōwazakura, and Yoshino cherry blossoms, as well as the Hirado and Golden Azalea blooming in the woods. Hike up the mountain or go for an outing to catch a glimpse of this beautiful flower festival.

## The Camphor Trail Flower Carnival



January to February / May to June / September to October

Location | Maokong Camphor Trail

The Camphor Trail is located on Section 7 of the Taipei Grand Trail. The surrounding floral scenery often changes with the seasons. The flat terrain makes it a suitable hiking trail for families with children. It is one of the most popular hiking trails in the Maokong area. While in Maokong, you can choose to join the flower carnival, drink some tea, go on mountainous hikes, or simply enjoy the night view of Taipei. You can also purchase the Maokong Gondola 1-Day Fun Pass to explore teahouses and take in the breathtaking landscape.

## Taipei Riverside Flower Carnival



January to February

Location | Guting Riverside Park

Mid-October to November

Location | Dajia Riverside Park

November to December

Location | Zhongzheng Riverside Park

Riverside parks in Taipei will be decorated with seasonal flowers and grass fields to create large-scale floral sceneries. Like a large canvas painted with bright and dazzling colors, the Taipei Riverside Flower Carnival provides open green spaces and spectacular views along the river, letting visitors wander in a romantic atmosphere amidst dreamy fields of flowers.

## Shilin Residence Tulip Festival



Late February

Location | CKS Shilin Residence Park

Known as "magical flowers" in Europe, tulips are loved by many for their graceful blooms and vivid colors. Each year, the Shilin Residence Tulip Festival features over 100,000 tulips from the Netherlands and Japan, arranged into exquisite floral fields. This allows visitors to experience the unique romantic charm of temperate flowers without having to travel abroad.

## Shilin Residence Chrysanthemum Festival



Late November to Mid-December

Location | CKS Shilin Residence Park

The Shilin Residence Chrysanthemum Festival, with a long-standing history of more than 20 years, is the largest flower festival in Taipei during the autumn season. In addition to commonly seen chrysanthemums, this year's festival features a number of unique and decorative varieties that are displayed with mixed media and installation art. Up to a thousand giant blooms and varied-shaped decorative Chrysanthemums are the achievement of professional horticulturists at the Shilin Resident Park, as it took them nearly two years to cultivate these species and complete the designs. Visit the park to celebrate the glorious festival and witness the beauty of chrysanthemums in full bloom.
